Tankered Domestic Waste Charges 2024 to 2025

From 1st April 2024, the prices for the reception and treatment of tankered domestic waste during normal opening hours are as follows:

Waste Strength	Non-dissolved Solids (mg/l)	Charge per m ³
Weak	Under 2,000	£3.21
Standard	2,001 to 9,000	£10.87
High	9,001 to 20,000	£18.94
Strong	20,001 plus	£28.01

In addition, a **£10.99 standing charge** applies to each tanker load discharged. All of the above are zero rated for VAT purposes.

Tankered Trade Waste

All existing waste streams will have the increase applied, whereas any new enquires will be priced on application based on the current cost of treating the waste.

Hazardous waste streams will not be accepted from the 1st of April. We are sorry that we will not be able to accept waste streams of this nature and apologise for any inconvenience this may cause to your business and that of your customers.
